Board services

Pasture Board-

Includes pasture maintenance ie rotating to rest pastures, mowing, spraying and fences. Water and minerals as well as hay in the winter months are provided. Horses are counted and monitored for any obvious injuries or illnesses. We will not pull your horse out regularly and examine. During spring rotation, horses may be moved to a different pasture for 30-90 days. This allows the grass to come in, fences and shelters to be maintained and weeds to be sprayed.

Run outs-

Runout includes hay and grain twice a day. Supplements will be added as requested at no at no additional charge (provided by owner). Water and minerals are also provided. We will turn your horse(s) out and bring them in three times per week (weather permitting). Blanketing and removing blankets as well as fly masks/sheets is included. Maintenance of the runouts is provided and includes cleaning every other day, grading and reapplying sand as needed, cleaning the automatic waterers and troughs as needed. Panels/gates will be repaired and/or replaced as needed. Turn out pastures will be maintained by TEC. A round bale will be provided in the turnout pastures during the winter months.

Stalls Full Care-

Full care stall boarding includes hay and grain twice a day. Supplements will be added as requested at no additional charge (provided by owner). Water and minerals are also provided. We will turn your horse(s) out and bring them in three times per week (weather permitting). Blanketing and removing blankets as well as fly masks/sheets is included. Maintenance of the stalls is provided and includes cleaning every other day and stripping and disinfecting as needed. We will disinfect buckets at least weekly. Fly sprayers and fans are provided. Turn out pastures will be maintained by TEC. A round bale will be provided in the turnout pastures during the winter months.

Other amenities:

The arena and round pen are provided for all boarders. Please be respectful of others using them. If we are hosting an event, the arena will be closed. We also close the arena occasionally for those boarders needing to practice their sport requiring the whole arena; barrels, poles, roping, etc.

The bathroom is also available for your use.

First aid kit and other medical products are in the bathroom for both horses and people. These products are provided for emergencies and not for on-going care. The tack room is designed for one spot per horse. Please do not exceed the space allotted to you.

Trails are maintained by TEC and volunteers. If you plan to use the trails, please sign up to help keep them clean and safe.

Additional services:

- 1. Pasture feeding Monday-Sunday \$80.00 or \$2.50 each time
- 2. Quarantine is available on a case-by-case basis. If quarantine is needed, this service is not optional as we must ensure the health and safety of all other horses.
- 3. Blanketing and removing blankets in the pasture is \$5 each.
- 4. Fly masks on and off in the pasture is \$5 each.
- 5. Grooming is available for \$5 each time.
- 6. Bathing can be done for \$20 each time.
- 7. Fly spraying can be done for an additional fee. Talk to the barn manager about this service.
- 8. Other services can be added by request to the Barn Manager.
- 9. Guests are allowed on the property provided a release of liability has been signed and the guests follow the TEC barn rules. Guests may haul in horses as long as prior arrangements have been made and the visiting horse has a proof of negative coggins.
- 10. There are additional charges for medical treatment ordered by a veterinarian or owner. This will be handled on a case-by-case basis. Some examples would be wrapping wounds and abscesses, treating scratches and rain rot, etc. We will not give injections, and we have the right to refuse medical treatment if the horse is potentially dangerous.
- 11. Worming will be handled by Trimble Equine Center and is an additional charge of \$22.00 in the months we worm and \$25.00 in the month we do the fecals. All horses will have a fecal test done at least annually. If the fecal test results are more than low, we will use the veterinarian recommended wormer. If a power pak is the recommendation, there will be an additional charge.
